

Things you really need to know:

Directions to Kirkwood Community Center:

From I-64 & I-270 (14 mi west of downtown St Louis) go south on I-270 4 miles—exit at Dougherty Ferry—turn left (east)

From I-44 & I-270 go north on I-270 2.5 miles—exit at Dougherty Ferry—turn right (east)

Then: continue 1/2 mile to first light—turn right on N Ballas.
In 1/2 mile stay to left at fork in road—continue on W Adams for over a mile—you will see park on your right. Turn right on S Geyer—community center is a short block on your right at the light.

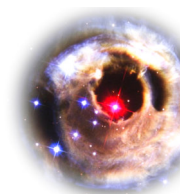
